

Albany Township Minutes
April 18, 2017

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with all members present. Proof of posting verified in 3 places, published and on the website. Oath of office was taken by the Board members for the coming 2 years. Abel Schultz is the new Chairman and Ron Krupke is the 1st Supervisor. The 2nd Supervisor, Treasurer and Clerk remain the same. The Board acknowledged the 19 years of service that Keith Hobson gave to the Town of Albany. Minutes of the last meeting were read and stand approved as read.

Treasurer's Report: The treasurer reported \$72,216.96 in Checking; \$189,661.39 in Savings; \$73,657.07 in the Building Fund; \$20,032.53 in the Machinery Fund and \$10,019.88 in the Reassessment Fund. State Highway Aids were received and are included in the Checking account. Grace checked with 4 municipalities on using purchase orders. All said they do not use purchase orders but the City of Brodhead has a voucher system. She will look into it further.

Public Input: Robert Bump asked about the water test that will take place in June. This is a voluntary test conducted by the Green County Extension.

Website: Still having some problems. Abel will meet with Wayne to correct them.

Plan Commission: Gus Harvel's sale of a 3 acre plot was approved with Green County asking about showing the entire parcel as one or as a separate parcel. Sugar River Crossing had a replat review. The plat looked good and new bylaws will be written up and need approval by our attorney.

Roads and Driveway Permits: Ryan Ethridge requested a driveway refund. He will be issued a check when he gets an occupancy permit. Ron Krupke and Abel Schultz attended Green County Government Day. They will meet with Pete to go over the roads on April 21. Peckham Rd. is need of grading. Someone will monitor it while they are doing the work to make sure it is ok. Cold patch prices were discussed. TRIP funds are available until 2021 but probably will be used before that. Eighteen rolls of snow fence were burned on the Jeremy Flood farm while he was burning fence rows. He will be billed \$74.00 per roll and for posts if the ones in the fire are not ok. There are some issues with one of the trucks but it will be repaired.

Building Inspector: No permits.

Assessor: No report.

Insurance: Another refund check for workman's comp. was received from Rural.

Library: A new Village representative will be needed as John Hlavachek resigned from the Board.

Recycling: No meeting. Acceptance Day will be April 22 from 8:00 to 3:00. A sharp's container will be installed at the recycling center .

Payment of Bills: Bills were signed by Chairman Hobson before the meeting as Abel Schultz will need to be put on as a check signer at the bank.

Other Business: The next regular meeting will be May 9.

Adjournment: A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to adjourn the meeting.
Motion carried 3-0.
