

## Albany Township Minutes

August 13, 2018

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance was shared. Proof of posting verified in three places, on the website and published. Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported \$54,327.41 in Checking; \$200,040.45 in Savings; \$81,364.82 in the Building Fund; \$37,606.95 in the Machinery Fund and \$17,538.46 in the Reassessment Fund. A motion was made by Krupke and seconded by Spangler to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Public Input: Alan and Darcy Stephenson were presented to see about lowering the speed limit in the subdivision off of Purinton Rd. Discussion was held. They will talk to the subdivision residents to see whether they wanted it lowered. The Board will check to see if they are specific speed limits for subdivisions. Two couples were present to see what can be done with a property on Albany-Brooklyn Rd that is in disrepair. They will keep trying to get something done by talking with the owner.

Website: Things are being put on in a timely manner.

Plan Commission: No report.

Roads and Driveway Permits: Ditch work was done on Tin Can and Stephenson Roads. The work was not on the list of projects for 2018. Black dirt was saved and may need to be used when the culvert is fixed on Tin Can Rd. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Schultz to refund \$500.00 to Derik Doescher on the completion of end caps on the driveway. Motion carried 3-0.

Building Inspector: There was one new house and one small permit for July.

Assessor: No report.

Insurance: No report.

Library: Evaluations of the director and workers will be done soon. A silent auction will be held in September and Snack with Santa will be at the Library this year. Ideas for programs and getting teachers involved with the library are being looked at.

Recycling: A meeting will be held August 20<sup>th</sup>. There are now 5 dumpsters and are being well used.

Other Business: Krupke is requesting the purchase of a weed trimmer. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Schultz to approve the purchase of a Stiehl FS240R weed trimmer not to exceed \$700.00. Motion carried 3-0. The truck purchase has not been finalized. The next regular Board meeting will be September 11.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to approve the payments of bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Adjournment: A motion as made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to adjourn. Motion carried 3-0.
