

Albany Township Minutes
January 2018

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance was shared. Proof of posting verified in three places, published and on the website. Minutes of the the last meeting were read and approved.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported \$1,202,673.40 in Checking; \$149,868.11 in Savings; \$78,771.56 in the Building Fund; \$30,063.74 in the Machinery Fund and \$15,029.14 in the Reassessment Fund. Noteworthy deposits were State Highway Aids of \$24,320.02 and \$1,168,606.10 from tax collections. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Public Input: Scott Roth asked about the December minutes not being on the website. The minutes are not posted to the website until they are approved at the following meeting.

Plan Commission: Nick Blumer was advised to change his lot so that it would comply with the rules of the Commission and will square it off. Bill Mordecai is working to correct an error that was made when his property was first surveyed. He may need a new CSM.

Roads and Driveway Permits: A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to approve a driveway permit for Jeff and Amber Frantz. Motion carried 3-0. Morton Farms wants a field access driveway permit into Wilbur McCreedy's land to connect with their driveway.

Schultz had a call for information on a subdivision. She will need to talk to the Plan Commission regarding this matter. Discussion held on having the Green County Highway Dept. trim trees along Township roads. Permission may be needed from the DNR along Tin Can Road.

Building Inspector: A house permit was given out for Psalms Way.

Assessor: The clerk will meet with the assessor regarding 2017 building permits.

Insurance: No report.

Library: The meeting is tonight.

Recycling: Krupke has been working with the Village to get information on the assessment for the past year.

Other business: The State Highway Aids will be \$97,280.00 for the coming year. The next regular Board meeting will be February 13. The Town's Association district meeting will be March 3 at Whitewater.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to pay the bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.
