

Albany Township Minutes
July 11, 2016

The Town Board met at the town hall with all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance was shared. Proof of posting verified in two places, published and on the website. Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Jamie Stephenson brought the new ambulance out and explained all the features.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported \$85,207.03 in Checking; \$189,940.13 in Savings; \$68,459.03 in the Building Fund; \$10,012.02 in the Machinery Fund and \$5,013.55 in the Reassessment Fund. The State Highway Aids and State Fire Dues were received and are in the Checking account. A deposit for \$7,500 in the Machinery Fund and \$2,500.00 for the Building and Reassessment Funds is being made at this meeting. An agreement was signed with the Green County Treasurer stating that there will be a \$250.00 flat fee plus \$1.00 per collected parcel will be charged starting with tax collection this year. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Schultz to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Public Input: No one present.

Website: No report.

Plan Commission: There was no meeting in July. The final CSM was received from the Wolfe transfer.

Roads and Driveway Permits. There is a driveway permit for Roy Kopp at the end of Deerwood Drive and a field driveway permit for Harvey Kopp on Peckham Rd. The road in Boots Drive was swept. There was a truck load of gravel, etc. The neighbors are happy with the results. A tree was down on McDermott Rd. It would have been easier to clean up with a grapple bucket. Schultz got some figures on a bucket. No decision made on this. All the patching is done on the roads and the County will begin sealing roads this week. A double seal will be put on the back half of Conservation Rd.

Building Inspector: No report.

Insurance: There is glass coverage on vehicles and tractors with no deductible.

Library: Next meeting is July 12.

Recycling: A bill was received for out half of expenses at the Center.

Other Business: A class from the Emergency Management office in Monroe was held. There could be more classes concerning high wind, flooding, etc. The next regular meeting will be August 8. Election will be held August 9.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Schultz to approve the bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.
