

Albany Township Minutes
July 11, 2017

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance was shared. Proof of posting verified in the newspaper, website and posted. Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported \$79,919.15 in Checking; \$189,732.33 in Savings; \$76,194.49 in the Building Fund; \$25,042.72 in the Machinery Fund and \$12,522.71 in the Reassessment Fund. State Highway Aids of \$20,902.48 and State Fire Dues of \$4,202.89 were received. She is working on an approval form for expenses. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Public Input: None.

Website: Working ok.

Plan Commission: No meeting. Two positions need to be filled.

Roads and Driveway Permits: A driveway permit was given out on Bud Lane and a field driveway permit was discussed for a person on English Settlement Rd. Permit fee for field driveways is \$500.00 and is returned when the driveway is finalized. Discussion held on extending a culvert on English Settlement. Discussion was held on putting a 45 mile per hour speed limit on Decatur-Albany Rd. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to change the speed limit to 45 mph on Decatur-Albany Rd contingent on getting Decatur Township approval too. Motion carried 3-0. A copy of road title Insurance for Shannon Rd and Lee Lane was received. Seal coating will start next week.

Building Inspector: One house permit and one small permit.

Assessor: No report.

Insurance: No report.

Library: Approved Julie Cousin for the Library Bd. Robb got a plant for the celebration of life for Louise Spring.

Recycling: The Township will not be purchasing bags. Residents will pay for bags when they bring in their own bags. The new skid steer has codes for who uses it and it will keep track of the hours of use. We need to be listed on title as part owner. The Village will be sending a bill for half of the extra that was paid that insurance did not cover.

Other Business: Robb wanted to thank Ron for moving everything out and in when the carpet was cleaned. Moratoriums were discussed. No action taken. The next regular Board meeting will be August 8.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to pay the bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.
