

Albany Township Minutes
June 12, 2018

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with 4 members present – Robb Spangler absent due to illness. The Pledge of Allegiance was shared. Proof of posting verified in three places, published and on the website. Minutes of the last meeting were approved.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported \$112,286.73 in Checking; \$249,982.10 in Savings; \$81,337.06 in the Building Fund; \$37,594.12 in the Machinery Fund and \$17,535.52 in the Reassessment Fund. A motion was made by Krupke and seconded by Schultz to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried 2-0.

Public Input: Scott Roth a resident of Bump Rd. thanked the Board for the 45 mph speed limit and the new signs on the road. It has made a difference.

Website: No report.

Plan Commission: They met with Sugar River Crossing and did not approve of the plan. Some changes are needed regarding the cul de sac.

Roads and Driveway Permits: A motion was made by Schultz and seconded by Krupke to refund \$500.00 to Jeff Franz on completion of his driveway as approved by the County and Township. Motion carried 2-0. A new driveway on Peebles Rd. not put in properly and will need to be corrected. Mowing roads has been started. Dunphy Rd. has been paved at the east end. Discussion held on getting cold patch from Wolf or County.

Building Inspector: There was one final and one house permit.

Assessor: Open book will be June 21 and Board of Review will be June 29.

Insurance: No report.

Library: No report.

Recycling: Pellateri has brought 4 collection bins. It seems to be going ok.

Other Business: Discussion on a truck and will be getting bids for leasing. Next regular Board meeting will be July 10th.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Schultz and seconded by Krupke to approve the bills as presented. Motion carried 2-0.
