

Albany Township Minutes
March 13, 2018

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance was shared. Proof of posting in three places, on the website and published. Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Treasurer's report: The Treasurer reported \$245,576.66 in checking; \$149,904.45 in Savings; \$78,797.04 in the Building Fund; \$30,078.12 in the Machinery Fund and \$14,031.58 in the Reassessment Fund. A motion was made by Krupke and seconded by Spangler to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Public Input: Discussion held on the reducing the speed limit on Bump Rd. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to consider a resolution reducing the speed limit on Bump Rd. to 45 miles per hour at the next Board meeting. Motion carried 3-0.

Website: Things are being posted timely.

Plan Commission: A meeting was held March 7. Offices were reassigned. Jason Cleasby will be Secretary and Wolfgang Pavlok will be Vice Chairman. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to approve the reassignment of officers. Motion carried 3-0. Discussion was held with Becky Hays regarding a possible purchase of land from Howard Berra.

Roads and Driveway Permits: A worksheet is to be sent to Green County Emergency Management with estimates of work done and supplies used with the February flooding. Green County Government Day will be April 16. Some roads are in need of cold patch. Peckham and Towns road need grading in the near future. A washout is at the end of Schaller Rd. The property owner there needs to fix it since the cause of it is on their property. A complaint of gravel on a yard in Pine Haven has been taken care of.

Building Inspector: One house and one completion.

Assessor: No report.

Insurance: No report.

Recycling: Next meeting will be March 19. Discussion on an upgrade of the skid steer owned by the recycling center.

Other Business: GCDC was unable to be at the meeting. Someone will come in April. Discussion held on possibility of leasing or buying a new or used truck. No decision at this time. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to have Monroe Truck repair the white truck with the amount not to exceed \$5,000. Motion carried 3-0. The clerk requested a raise for election workers from \$7.25 now paid. Discussion held. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to raise the rate to \$10.00 per hour. Motion carried 3-0. Election is April 3. The next regular Board meeting is April 10.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to approve the payment of bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Adjournment: A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to adjourn. Motion carried 3-0.
