

Albany Township Minutes  
May 9, 2018

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance was shared. Proof of posting was in 3 places, published and on the website. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to approve the April minutes after a correction of the Board meeting being on May 9 rather than May 8. Motion carried 3-0.

Road Bids Opened: The bids for TRIP work on Dunphy Rd. were received: Rock Road Co, \$102,928.46; Green County Highway Commission, \$91,142.00; Payne & Dolan, \$99,193.75. After discussion on the bids a motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to award the bid to Payne & Dolan not to exceed \$99,193.75. Motion carried 3-0. A representative from Fahrner Asphalt gave a presentation on GSB-88 sealer on pavement. The bid was \$22,425.00. Discussion was held on Norwegian Road at approximately \$7200; English Settlement Bridge repair at \$13,500; repairs on Decatur-Albany Rd after flooding at \$5,000.00, and the cost to finish Dunphy Rd. The decision will be tabled until May 17 at 6:30 p.m.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported \$129,395.49 in Checking; \$249,950.25 in Savings; \$78,823.39 in the Building Fund; \$30,088.18 in the Machinery Fund and \$15,034.10 in the Reassessment Fund. Deposit to the funds will be made this month. Lottery credit, DNR and Recycling funds were received. A motion was made by Krupke and seconded by Spangler to approve the Treasurer's report as presented.

Public Input: A resident of Bump Rd. asked when new speed limits signs would be put up. Krupke will be doing that tomorrow.

A representative from Bug Tussel was present to talk about the tower going up on County E south of Albany. She explained that it would be available for 5 miles. Other customers can lease a place on the tower from them. They have several towers in Green County.

Website: No report.

Plan Commission: No report.

Roads and Driveway Permits: a permit was given out on English Settlement Rd. for a speck house. Field access driveways should be a minimum of 30'.

Building Inspector: Had 4 small permits. It has been a busy spring for him.

Assessor: No date for Open Book or Board of Review yet.

Insurance: No report.

Library : No report.

Recycling: Next meeting will be May 14. A motion was made by Schultz and seconded by Krupke to approve having three recycling bins furnished by Pellateri. Motion carried 3-0.

Other Business: Discussion on leasing a truck rather than buying one. A road work project meeting will be held May 17 at 6:30 p.m. The Board will also open the Board of Review meeting and adjourn it to a later date when the book is finished. The next regular Board meeting will be June 12.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to approve the payment of bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Adjournment: A motion was made by Krupke and seconded by Spangler to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 3-0.
