

Albany Township Minutes  
November 9, 2016

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance was shared. Proof of posting verified in three places, published and on the website. Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

After the Public Budget Hearing and the Special Town Meeting of Electors to approve the 2016 levy per Wisconsin Statutes 60.10(1)(a) the Town Board met to approve the levy. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Schultz to approve the 2016 levy of \$276,527.00 for the 2017 budget. Motion carried 3-0.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported \$44,727.13 in Checking; \$124,575.25 in Savings; \$71,096.80 in the Building Fund; \$17,520.56 in the Machinery Fund and \$7,516.02 in the Reassessment Fund. Spangler made a motion seconded by Hobson to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Plan Commission: No report.

Roads and Driveway Permits: Krupke is doing some mowing and putting in snow fence. There will need to be speed limit signs in the Dunphy subdivisions. Shouldering was done in these subdivisions and it is ready for Greg Hofmeister to accept as complete. The salt from Green County is \$71.00 this year and is down from \$72.50 last year. Hobson talked to Jeff Wuenschel regarding raising the rent for the garage. It has not been raised in many years. A motion was made by Schultz and seconded by Spangler for Hobson to write a short letter to Jeff to present to the County raising the rent to \$2400.00. Motion carried 3-0.

Building Inspector: Some small permits and a house permit.

Assessor: A bill was received for the annual assessors report.

Library: Abel Schultz wrote a letter to the Library Board to start a maintenance fund for any large repairs that will someday be needed such as roof, furnace, etc. This is in agreement with what the Town Board feels is necessary. The next library meeting will be December 6.

Recycling: A large amount was brought in for acceptance day. There were angry Villagers regarding not being able to have curbside pickup.

Other business: The next regular meeting will be December 13. The Green County Towns Assn will meet on November 16.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Schultz to approve the bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Adjournment: A motion was made by Schultz and seconded by Spangler to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 3-0.
