

Albany Township Minutes
November 2017

The Town Board met with all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance was shared. Proof of posting was verified as posted in 3 places, on the website and published. Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported \$40,733.46 in Checking; \$189,828.25 in Savings; \$76,245.87 in the Building Fund; \$25,059.62 in the Machinery Fund and \$12,526.95 in the Reassessment Fund. Some money will be transferred from the Savings to Checking due to the payment of the current bills. The Treasurer attended the County Treasurer's meeting and has information for the collection of taxes. An informational flyer will be sent with the taxes and put on the website. A bond, resolution or ordinance is needed before taxes are collected to cover the amount of the County Taxes. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to purchase a bond. Motion carried 3-0.

Public Input: None.

Website: No report.

Plan Commission: No meeting. There is a need for two more members.

Roads and Driveway Permits: Schultz gave out one driveway permit to Ben and Tracy Millard. Krupke will meet with them for placement of the driveway, etc. From now on the patrolman will be responsible for meeting with future driveway applicants. The application will be approved at the following Board meeting. TRIP funds of \$22,000.00 were approved for Purintun Rd and will be available for 5 years. New culverts on Atkinson Rd and Dunphy Rd were installed but no end walls were put on. Mowing is nearly done and snow fences are going up.

Building Inspector: One small permit was given.

Assessor: No report.

Insurance: Yearly billing will be paid in December.

Library: The budget was approved. Wilbur McCreedy has decided to not be on the Board after many years of serving. They are working on replacement for him and on the strategic plan.

Recycling: Krupke gave a preliminary report on recycling. He will have more information at the next Board meeting.

Other Business: A new fuel tank is needed for the truck. Prices were gotten and it will be purchased from Alumi Tank Co. The Green County Towns meeting will be November 15. Discussion held on purchasing a trailer to haul the skid steer. The next regular meeting will be December 12.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to approve the payment of bills as presented with the exception of the recycling bill. Motion carried 3-0.

Adjournment: A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 3-0.
