

Albany Township Minutes
October 11, 2016

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with all members present. Proof of posting verified in two places, published and on the website. Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Treasurer's report: The Treasurer reported \$48,456.28 in Checking; \$124,559.38 in Savings; \$7,515.38 in the Reassessment Fund; \$17,518.32 in the Machinery Fund and \$71,084.72 in the Building Fund. State Highway Aids of \$20,902.50 were received. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Schultz to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Public Input: A couple from the Village was present to request their presence at the next Recycling meeting.

Website: No report.

Plan Commission: Sugar River Crossing LLC was present to change the size of lots. They will have to do a new preliminary plat to start this process. There are some issues to be resolved. A check for \$5,000.00 was given to the Plan Commission for this new plat.

Roads and Driveway Permits: Everson Road is not done yet. Road work is close to being done on Towns Rd. There may need to be a sign designating pavement to gravel. Shamrock Estates has the shouldering done and it needs packing. Speed limit signs are needed in subdivisions Yahweh, Hosanna and Shamrock. Schultz got a bid for cold patch of \$84.00 per ton from Scott Construction. A tree is being worked on along Zurfluh Rd. The Bridge Report was received and the things that need doing are finished. English Settlement bridge will need rip rap next year and needs bridge markers.

Building Inspector: No report.

Insurance: No report.

Library: A meeting will be held next week. A budget request was received from them. The Board feels There is a need for maintenance reserves for future library repairs.

Recycling: A meeting will be held next week. Acceptance Day is September 15.

Other Business: A letter received regarding testing drinking water in the township next June. The budget meeting will be held November 9 at 6:30 p.m. followed by the regular Board meeting.

Payment of bills: A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Schultz to approve the bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.
