

UNOFFICIAL MINUTES

Albany Township Minutes

October 10, 2017

The Board met at 6:00 p.m. to work on the budget. The meeting was adjourned at 6:40 p.m.

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance was shared. Proof of posting verified in three places, published and on the website. Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported \$45,923.48 in Checking; \$189,804.07 in Savings; \$76,232.92 in the Building Fund; \$25,055.36 in the Machinery Fund and \$12,525.88 in the Reassessment Fund. The purchase order form was approved with the addition of a date on the form. Verbal approval for something needed before a purchase order can be filled out was approved. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Public Input: Mara Speich and Kelly Gildner were present to discuss minor damage to tombstones in English Settlement cemetery. Wolfgang Pavlok was also present to discuss the cemetery. There are only two members on the cemetery association board. Discussion was held on what could be done in the future. No decision made at this time. The Town Board has no jurisdiction on cemeteries at this time.

Website: No report.

Plan Commission: No meeting. Two new members are needed.

Roads and Driveway Permits: A resident on Jericho wants to put a building on a second lot. The building must be off the lot line. Greg Hofmeister met with another land owner on Jericho drive to determine the road right of way for this owner. Derik Doescher wants to move his new house driveway 12 feet to the south.

Building Inspector: A house permit and another small permit were given out in September.

Assessor: No report.

Insurance: No report.

Library: Silent auction fund raiser was held and the 10th anniversary of the library was held on October 7th. The outside work has been completed. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to be exempt from the County Library Tax. Motion carried 3-0.

Recycling: Acceptance day will be October 14th from 8:00 to 3:00. An Agreement for Utilization of the Green County Solid Waste Transfer Station was signed by the Chairman. Motion carried 3-0.

Other Business: Krupke asked about getting snow fence and posts for Bump Rd. location. Suggestions were made for additional snow plow drivers. The pole saw needs the motor fixed. It was decided to see about fixing it rather than buying a new saw. The next regular Board meeting will be November 14 following the Budget Hearing.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to pay the bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Adjournment: A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 3-0.
