

UNOFFICIAL MINUTES

Albany Township Minutes

September 19, 2017

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance was shared. Proof of posting was verified in three places, on the website and in the newspaper. Minutes of the last meeting were read with a correction of the spelling of Paul Larsen's name being wrong and the property is north of the 6600 block of English Settlement Road. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to approve the minutes as corrected.

Treasurer's Report: A tax settlement of \$86,057.57 was received in August. The Treasurer reported \$117,999.84 in Checking; \$189,780.67 in Savings; \$76,220.39 in the Building Fund; \$25,052.24 in the Machinery Fund and \$12,524.85 in the Reassessment Fund. Two payments were received from delinquent personal property. The annual tax collection agreement with Green County was signed. The purchase order is still being perfected. There will be Clerk and Treasurer meetings with the Green County Treasurer this fall. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Public Input: None.

Plan Commission: No report.

Roads and Driveway Permits: Driveway permits given to Derik Doescher and Nick Blumer. A request was received from a resident on Jericho Drive regarding set back for a garage on a second lot. Greg Hofmeister will be contacted regarding this. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to refund Dan Dunphy \$500.00 for the successful completion of his driveway to Township standards. Motion carried 3-0. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Schultz to refund \$500.00 to Paul Larsen for the successful completion of his field driveway in the 6600 block of English Settlement Rd. Motion carried 2-1.

Building Inspector: One small permit.

Assessor: Market drive information received.

Insurance: No report.

Library: Silent auction coming up. Outside maintenance will be done.

Recycling: Spangler made a motion seconded by Krupke to approve the rate increases in materials other than bags of the August 2017 Joint Recycling Committee meeting. Motion carried 3-0. Starting October 1 the hours of operation at the recycling center will be 1:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. on Wednesdays and no change to the Saturday hours.

Other business: Estimated population this year is 1125. A non-discrimination paper was signed and returned to Green County. Preliminary budget figures were given to the Board. The next regular meeting will be October 10 starting at 6:00 p.m. with budget work and the regular Board meeting to follow.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to approve the payment of bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Adjournment: A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 3-0.
