

2017 Important Tax Information

The Township of Albany has contracted with Green County for processing the collection of first and full payment of real and personal property taxes for the 2017 tax bills. Payments can be made in person at the Green County Treasurer's Office located in the Green County Courthouse, 1016 16th Ave., Monroe, WI Monday through Friday 8:00 am to 4:30 pm. Check their website for their holiday schedule. Payments can also be mailed to the same address. If you require a receipt, please include a self-addressed stamped envelope with your payment.

The following financial institutions will also process collection of first and full payments:

Associated Bank – Monroe
Sugar River Bank - Monroe, Belleville, Brodhead and Juda
The Bank of New Glarus –New Glarus
Union Bank and Trust – New Glarus and Brooklyn
Monona Bank – Brooklyn and Belleville
Greenwoods State Bank – Monticello

Payments may also be made on the Green County Website at www.co.green.wi.gov. The convenience fee for the use of E-check is \$1.50. Credit/Debit fee is 2.39%

NOTE: If a third party (i.e. financial institution or mortgage company) is paying your taxes, please relay to them that tax payments must be sent to Green County Treasurer as noted on the tax bill.

****There will be no tax collection at the Township Hall.**

Dog Licensing

Chapter 174 of the Wisconsin Statute requires owners of dogs more than 5 months of age on January 1 shall annually pay the dog license tax and obtain a license. All Green County dog licenses for dogs residing in Albany Township must be purchased via U.S. Mail. Cost is \$5.00 per spayed/neutered dog and \$10.00 per unaltered dog. Multiple dog licenses are available for \$35.00 for 12 or fewer dogs and an additional \$3.00 for each dog in excess of 12. A late fee of \$5.00 per dog *could* be assessed if a license is not obtained by April 1. Remit payment along with a copy of your **Vet Certification** for each dog showing date of rabies vaccination to:

Make checks payable to the Town of Albany. Allow 10 days for processing. Make sure a return address is included.
