

ORDINANCE 1-2018

STATE OF WISCONSIN

Town of Albany

Green County

The Town Board of the Town of Albany, Green County, Wisconsin has the specific authority under s.349.11, Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain town highways in the town as follows:

- A. Pursuant to s.349.11, Wis. stats., effective April 10, 2018, speed limits on certain Town of Albany town highways are reduced or modified as follows: Decreasing the speed limit on Bump Road from 55 miles per hour to 45 miles per hour
- B. Pursuant to s. 349.11(5), Wis. stats., the town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highway in violation of the above-noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60, Wis stats.

This ordinance is effective on April 17, 2018. S

The town clerk shall property post or publish this notice as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
